A SAD DEATH.

Woman Bears the Shame While Destroyer Goes Free.

On Sunday at a house of ill fame near the river, a young woman died under circumstances that are extremely sad. This young woman—or rather girl, as she was only about 17 years old—went by the name of Bessie Miller, and recently became a mother. A child not quite five weeks old being left upon the charity of the world.

Some kind people of the town looked after the needs of the unfortunate girl during her sickness and will endeavor to get someone to take the child.

The history of this girl's downfall is told in a few lines: She and a smaller sister were left orphans and were placed in an orphanage. She had an aunt whose husband came to town in Greenville, and when the family came here this girl who lived with them was brought along. This uncle by marriage, instead of being the protector of the girl, took advantage of her youth and innocence and wrought her ruin, and when it became apparent that the crime would be exposed by the girl becoming a mother, she was put out of his home and placed in a house of ill fame.

During her sickness the girl was very repentant, and said she was spared to get out of her surroundings she would endeavor to make her life what it ought to be. When it was known that she could not live it she said she made a dying statement which she had made repeatedly before, that the uncle was the author of her ruin.

The unfortunate girl asked that she might have a Christian burial. This was given her this morning in Cherry Hill Cemetery. Rev. H. M. Eare conducting services at the grave. A number of the best people of the town attended the funeral thus showing their sympathy for such a sad ending of a young life.

Humanity may let such a crime go unpunished, but God in His justice will call the author of this girl's ruin to an awful account.
