PITT DELEGATES

ANTS AND FLIES.
A Naturalist Proves How They Disperse Years and Molds.
The part played by insects in the distribution of minute vegetable organisms has been the subject of an interesting investigation by Prof. Andrew Barnes at the Pitts Academy for Agricultural Chemistry. That they do perform this task, often a very mischievous one, has long been known, but the professor, as is shown in the current number of Nature, has proved that for good or evil, they are more active than had been hitherto ascertained. Ants were the subjects of his first experiments. He had frequently observed that cells of two algalic yeasts hidden in fissures of the bark of trees were always surrounded by larvae of ants. These were suspected to have been transported by the ants, which were constantly traveling up and down the trunks, and it seemed likely that cells might co-operate in the work. First, he put the yeast in water, then placed it in a large number of a species which is very common in vineyards. They were allowed access to bunches of grapes which had been carefully sterilized and afterward placed under conditions that prevented the growth of yeasts from the outer air. The result, in less than a week, was that all the bunches which the ants could visit were abundantly infested with yeasts and molds, while several others which had been preserved even for a month showed no signs of fermentation. In sterilized bunches from which the ants were excluded had neither molds nor yeasts or bacteria on their surfaces.
