THE NEW YORK

Here are some of the things that must be done under the provisions of the new war tax law:

Put a two-cent revenue stamp on every check or sight draft.

Cancel the stamp by writing on it with ink your initials and date.

Put a two-cent stamp on every instant bill of exchange, time draft, promissory note or money order for each \$100.

Pay one cent extra on each telegraph message sent.

Pay eight cents per \$100 on each life insurance policy, unless taken on the plan of weekly payments, when the charge is 40 per cent of the first weekly payment.

Pay 25 cents on each one-year lease, 50 cents on a lease between one and three years, and \$1 on a lease exceeding three years.

Pay 25 cents on each mortgage between \$1,000 and \$1,500, and 25 cents on each \$500 additional.

Pay 10 cents extra every time you occupy a seat or berth in a parlor or sleeping car.

Pay a tax ranging from 75 cents to \$15 per \$100 on legacies above \$10,000, according to the total value.

Pay 30 cents tax on a surety bond.

Pay one cent a pint on wines.

Pay 25 cents on each protested note.

VANDERBILT'S START.

Daniel Drew's Story of the Holy Ghost.

"One story about Commodore Cornelius Vanderbilt was told to me many years ago by Daniel Drew, and I have no doubt but that it is authentic," said a man who has known intimately the man who has made New York history during the last half century.

The report of the grand jury on the condition of affairs at the County Home reveals a state of affairs that is a discredit to the County. The system of consigning these unfortunate people to the care of the lowest bidder is cold blooded cruelty that should be discontinued in any civilized community. We understand that the price paid to the present keeper is only \$2.00 a month each. They cannot afford at this price to give the inmates the care the county owes them. Here is a good field for reform. A new system should be adopted.

Section 7 of the act provides that if any person or persons shall make, sign or use any instrument, document or paper of any description whatsoever, without the same being duly stamped for the tax thereon, the said person or persons shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall pay a fine of not more than \$100. Telegraphic dispatches are enumerated in the act as requiring the documentary one cent stamp.

Section 15 of the act imposes upon the telegraph company a penalty of \$10 for transmitting any dispatch or message that has not been stamped in accordance with section 7.

You are further advised that the exemption of the messengers of officials and employees of railroad companies as provided in section 15, is strictly limited to the transmission of those messages between stations on the respective systems of railroads of the railroad companies. All dispatches or messages of railroad officials and employees sent from railroad stations on their respective railroads must be stamped by their makers, signers or issuers, in accordance with section 7.
