Gov. Jarvis at Murfreesboro.

Our townsman ex-Gov. T. J. Jarvis, delivered the commencement address at the Woman Baptist Female Institute, Murfreesboro, last Wednesday. Speaking of it the Murfreesboro Index says:

The address delivered by Gov. Jarvis on "The Republic's need of an educated womanhood," was a sound, practical and uplifting. The speaker recognized the dangers threatening our republic but did not regard them from a pessimistic standpoint. If there are real dangers already appearing as a menace to our nation, they are seen coming not from without but from within. We have nothing to fear from attack by a foreign foe, since the opportunity never fails to develop a Leon a Grant, a Garfield or a Dewey. If our downfall does come to our republic, it must come through the disintegration of our social institutions.

The speaker remarked that he never had any sympathy for the idea of woman's suffrage, since he has never believed her place to be at the ballot box, nor is it her province to have recourse with the sternness to the awful arbitrament of war. He believed woman's power should be exerted in the home where she is the most influential. It is not her province to lead, surely the sons will be. Give me true womanhood educated in heart and mind and I don't care who makes the laws of the country. Sometimes we have instances of strong men coming from north and south, while we see men who were carefully trained in prisons, but who are not the exception and not the rule. Woman's power is exerted in behalf of a just and healthy civilization and her strong convictions of God and unflinching fidelity to duty are to be the safeguard of the Church.

The speaker closed with a beautiful illustration drawn from the different aspect of a high mountain near the city of Rio Janeiro, Brazil. There were midway stations where the tourists were tempted to linger and be satisfied with the beauties that met the eye, but the most beautiful sight to behold was from the summit. He urged the young ladies not to be satisfied with the attainments and beauties of the present, but to strive on till the highest ideal in life should be realized.
