MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES EAST CAROLINA COLLEGE Greenville, N. C.

May 17, 1952

The Board of Trustees of East Carolina College met in the board room at the college Saturday afternoon, May 17, 1952. Prior to the meeting, members present were guests at the alumni luncheon.

Present: Messrs. Erwin, Belk, White, Tyler, Garrett, Carroll, Stedman, Cox, and Mrs. Williams.

Absent: Dr. Swindell, Misses Palmer and Hall, and Mr. Clark.

The Board approved for graduation, May 19, candidates for
the A.B. degree, 15; B.S., 127; M.A., 26.

The board accepted the resignation of Mr. W. E. Dole and Mrs. Dole.

The appointment of Clyde A. Biggers as assistant coach and teacher of physical education was approved.

Paul E. Powell, of the Industrial Arts department, was granted a year's leave of absence to study.

The recommendation of the President that Carl L. Adams, head of the department of psycholocy, Miss Ola Ross, assistant registrar, and Mr. L. L. Rives, cafeteria steward, who have reached retirement age, be continued for another year was approved.

The president announced that J. L. Williams, nightwatchman, will retire this year.

Dr. Messick reported the progress of the training school-college negotiations, and read an eleven-point agreement signed by J. H. Rose, city superintendent, J. B. James, chairman of the city school board, and by him. After discussion, the board passed the following resolution, introduced by Mr. Garrett, and seconded by Mr. Stedman:

"The Board of Trustees accepts and approved this agreement between the college and city school system on a one-year basis, effective September 1, 1952, with the understanding that the training school set-up is to be reviewed a year hence."
