

# U.S.-China Group Works For Freedom on Mainland

After several months of preparation, the new Sino-American Coordinating Council held its first meeting March 23, in New York.

Dedicated to promoting "true friendship and understanding between the American and Chinese peoples," the organization states that "these relations have been marred by the imposition of the Communist ideology on the Chinese mainland."

"This ideology and its political apparatus are totally inimical to both Chinese and American traditions and spirit."

The organization elected Richard T.T. Liu, Chairman of


the Association of Free Chinese in the United States, as its first president. Ron Pearson of Young Americans for Freedom was elected vice-president.

The Council is expected to provide a means of communication and coordinatied action among groups and individuals concerned with opposing Communism in China.

Other groups participating in the organization include The Taiwan Welfare Association, Freedom Leadership Foundation, World Youth Crusade for Freedom, Freeman Monthly and Committee For a Free China.


