Dear Father

It snowed very hard
yesterday and the examination
was put off until Monday. I
had a great deal of fun in the
snow yesterday snowballing the
men down town Mr Whitbread
and Dr Cott wallowed me in
the snow two or three times. The
Trustees went up to the Academy
to hear the boys speak their dialogues
Thursday afternoon, and we boys
went up there Friday morning
but it snowed so hard that
Mr Wiley put it off until Monday
night. I was very much disaff-
onted because I could not go a
game on account of the rain.
