Dear Father,

Mr Alfred Stanley has just arrived here from Washington he mailed some papers and letters to you in Tarboro. He says there are only 200 Yankees in Washington and a force of 500 good men will take the place he is now waiting to see General Leeingman on this business I suppose. I have seen Sam Chancet, Mr Heavy and a good many friends that I know. This is a good chance for your company to show their valor I have no doubt from Mr Stanley descupslion that the Gen - will send a force down immediately and if you want to go now is your chance. Please mail to me any of my letters that you may find in the office
