

Green Heath, Pitt County,
May 15th 1863

My Dear Father

I arrived here this morning about
9 P.M., on the boat, and succeeded in getting
my two boxes, and Aunt Annie's trunk safely
to this destination. Thinking that you would be
glad and anxious to hear of this safe arrival
I concluded to write you immediately. On my
way down I met "St. Stephen Spanner" and he
accompanied me down, he will remain with us
a few days. Mr. Foreman is not here at present
having gone to Tarboro yesterday but will return
on Sunday. I procured some fishing poles this
evening, and tomorrow we will try the fish.

All the family are well and send love. I
can think of nothing to write now that would
interest you but will write more shortly.
