July 15th 1863

Dear Father I arrived here safely,
about 5 P.M. yesterday, and joined
the Company last night. I am satis-
fied that I have done well, and
shall be contented to remain. There
is in the Company about 110 men,
Louis Reid, Carnes Bryan, John Selby
Jimmie Blount, Ed. Small and
myself mess and tent together. If
you more to know in that mess
I would be glad to have any
of your mess things you can
spare if you will send them
to Willards store I will get them.
Please send me a few clay
pipes. Write to me
