Dear Father

Since the mail carrier has stopped taking passengers he is much more punctual in bringing the mail. All the things sent per Steamer were duly received for which I am very much obliged. The oats are all planted - my half will grow me enough forage. For this & part of another year I am very anxious about Mother myself, I should like get any worse want you to let me know. When you come up to Pitt Creek I would like for you to come up here on Saturday stay over Sunday & take a look at my farm. Would be glad for you to come home if you could.
