My "New Father"

I send Tom down with a mule & cart for the baseb Pork if it be in Washington. if not for enough to last me untill its arrival. Day 50 pounds. Tom wants "for himself" 2 shirts and a pair shoes. Tom of the 16th containing one from Mr Joseph Mills, weired. I think he is very much mistaken about crops here, at least. We would send some fruit, but there is none here now that would pay for transportation down. All well & send love to you & family. You say nothing about coming up. I would like very much for you to see my crops. Could you arrange to come next week you might get a seab. backstab us.
