July 28<sup>th</sup> 1861

Sir

I received some days since an order from Walter Gwynn commanding Gen<sup>l</sup> of this Department requiring me to assign the house lately occupied by you, to Rev E A Best, Chaplain to the Regiment for his quarters. Please deliver his bed & cot & bedding now in the Marine Hospital to the bearer of this and give him the key to the house that he may take these articles there. If for any reason this may not be convenient to you at present send the cot there & deliver the key to Rev. Mr. Best on his return to this post.

My reason for naming the matter to day is because I learn you think of leaving the post tomorrow
