Captain

Your letter of the 3rd inst, asking for a transfer to Colonel Lew's Regiment, has been received and submitted to the Governor. He directs me to request you to notify this office as soon as your company is enlisted for the war, and orders will be immediately sent to you relieving you from duty at your present station, with directions to come to this city. Report to this office the number of men who decline enlisting for the war, giving their names in full. They will in all probability be attached to Captain Swindell's Company. Those of them who wish to enter the U. S. Navy, and are sailors, will be discharged by you agreeable to General Orders No 11 from this Office: or if they cannot enlist there, will be brought here to enlist.
