Sir

Complaints having been made to me to day by the authorities commanding here, that the Quarters of my men, now Prisoners of war at Castle Williams are not kept clean & in good condition - you are required to go to the Castle, examine its condition, & in what is required to to make & keep it clean in the way of tubs Mops & brushes, have it put in good clean condition, after which an Officer will be detailed each day to see that it is kept clean - you will require the orderly Sergeants of each Company to so arrange their Companies, that a certain number of men may be each day detailed for Police duty -

You will also in consultation with Dr Pool detail two men to act as permanent attendants on the Hospital - you will also detail three men to aid Dr Peters as long as he may need them in fixing up the Hospital -
