This indenture made this 12th day of February in the year of Our Lord 1823 Between Alexander Parish of the one part and Edmund Brinkley of the other part both of Chuman County and State of N. C. Witnesses that I the said Alexander Brinkley for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand Dollars to me in hand paid by the said Edmund Brinkley the receipt & do hereby acknowledge and therewith content and paid have bargained & sold unto the said Edmund Brinkley a certain tract of land lying and being in the county aforesaid, bounded and bounded as follows beginning at the Virginia road near the Deek river branch then up the various courses of the branch to a bridge across the bear swamp road then up the procosin swamp to the center of five pines Nathan Parches corner then along Parish's line to the Virginia road thence down Virginia road to first station containing fifty three $\frac{1}{2}$ acres, be the same more or less to him the said Brinkley his heirs and assigns forever and I the said Parish do for myself my heirs and assigns forever warrant and defend the above bargained premises unto him the said Brinkley his heirs and assigns forever: In witness whereof I have
