Letter dated May 20, 1946 from my mother to my father

Dear husband and father,

we are so pleased that you finally received some mail from us, but Please do not write all the time that you are going to be released soon, for we have been waiting and waiting. We are happy that you don't starve..our good deed has paid off..how many hungry men have we fed in the past.

But the children and I myself are facing very difficult times right now..there is always the problem of not having enough food.Luckily I have a garden now where I can plant some vegetables and harvest hopefully some fruit...tomorrow we should have our very first strawberries!

Our son Armin will have surgery, it is the same problem as before. The girls are healthy, thank God. There is nothing to report about me, you probably don't miss me at all, you always ask about the children. It is fine with me..you never spoiled me...

By the way, I am sporting a new hairstyle, and everyone around here says it is very becoming.
