Orders for Thursday May 23rd 1861.

- No. 1. Lieut Thomas officer for the day.
- " 2. The Reveille will sound at day break, and the Men will form on the front Carrou fifteen Minutes hereafter to answer to roll call.
- " 3. Breakfast at 7 A. M. The Chiefs of Squads will call their Mess rolls at every Meal, & report absentees to the Orderly Sergeant, who will report to the Officer for the day.
- " 4. Morning drill at 9 A. M. for two hours.
- " 5. Dinner at 1 P. M.
- " 6. Afternoon drill at 4 O'clock.
- " 7. Retreat will sound at sunset for the purpose of warning the officers & Men for duty, & reading the orders of the day. Roll call at Retreat.
