appeared before this board for recommendation for extension of Furlough, we do hereby certify that we have care-
fully examined him, and find that (make a full statement of the case.) *he still suffers from chronic*

gastric enteritis, with excessive debility and great
emaciation. He is physically unable to report to his command.

And in consequence thereof, he will not, in our opinion, be fit for duty in a less period than *Thirty (30)*
days, for which time we recommend an extension of his Furlough.
