I received your letter + was

I'm feeling fine + hope to hear  
the same from you.

Well kid it does look like  
the army is going to get you. Just  
hope you'll get rejected. Well  
you couldn't wait + you went +  
volunteered. It was the saddest  
day when you went + volunteered.  
You'll be kicking yourself after  
a couple of weeks of army life. Maybe  
be you won't if you get in a good  
camp. But me I'm in the worst  
camp in U.S.A. I hope the ship  
us in a good camp + maybe I won't  
mind the army life. I got to admit  
I've been having a good lately. It  
was bad at first, but it gets

to get better after a while. If you  
get a chance, take the navy. I be-  
lieve its a lot easier + a better place.  
I wished I was in the navy instead  
of the army. I don't think your crazy,  
if you get a chance to get in the  
navy.

Kid if you think its lousy weather  
thier. You should be down here. Some  
days its hot as hell. Then its rains  
& you have to walk in mud up  
to your hips. Thier no scenery  
at all around. Its just like a  
desert. Maybe if you get in the  
army. They put you in this camp.  
It bet<sup>10</sup> that you won it like.

Well how does it feel to break  
in a new kid? It was the same  
way with me when I broke you  
in. HAKA. Does he have to take  
care of the gate too? Cheap up  
kid. Better days are coming.

How is Myra Kulis? <sup>Is she</sup>  
bossy? I don't think she is. I  
[May 16, 1943]  
thought she was a swell Boss.  
Even if I did go out with her  
niece. By the way. Did you ever  
go out with Rosemary her niece?  
you said you were. Well maybe  
when she sees you in your army  
or Navy uniform she'll probably go  
out with you. Have you been out  
with any of the girls from down  
the mill?

Frankie tell me something. How  
come they didn't put some of the  
other fellows on your job? The  
ones that were there before this  
kid they got now or they all new.  
I heard all the fellows they got  
now are all kids.

very much to say. So'll close
