I was going to write to you
yesterday but last thur. when
I took the bike to go out near
Knoto lake to mow Mr.

Sandoff's lawn the chain almost
broke on the way home and then
Thur & Sat I worked at the
Shondoff store, and I didn't
have a chance to fix the bike
until last night. and
what a time I had it
took me from about 8.00.
to 10.00 at night to fix it.

I lost the letter you wrote me
 and if you asked any ques. I
 guess I won't be able to ans. them.
 I work a shandoffs store for
 4 days and on Tues and Fri
 I mow the lawn. I do almost
 the same a peter Moslow does
 Clean up and open packages
 and things as such. I hope
 you understand my writing,
~~and~~ I'll tell you how
 things? Do you like
 the Navy?

For three days I worked
 make \$7.50 I get a salary
 of \$15 a week this week
 will be my full week.
 I didn't get a Social Security
 card yet. and I don't intend
 to. Well we've live in the
 new house a week now and
 it's not to bad. I've got a
 nice parlor set and got a
 rocking chair like smily
 only smaller for \$6. or might
 get a lamp. Mama has a
 nice room and a nice light
 and a complete bedroom.
