Hi Frank.

I was very glad to hear from
of you. How the hell are you I
am fine I hope you are the same.

So you on a destroyer boy I
wish I was on it too instead of this
here army. Sam Gasbome got shipped
over and it won't be long before I get
shipped over too. You went lying
maybe you will escort the troopship
I am going to be on. I expect to get
shipped over just as soon as I come
back from my furlough the last cycle
that was here is in North Africa now.

I think were going down to the South
Pacific but I am not sure. There
so many rumors you can't believe
anything you hear up here but I
know I am going on the Banana
Boat that's what they call a troopship
up here. I am not going to tell my

mother nothing about it either. How are
the woman treating you are you getting
much. The weather up here is lousy
we had to march out to the Water
Range in mud up to our ankles boy I'll
be glad to get out of here they can
show the South up their ass. Jude
De tamin son the army now boy their
taking all the boys away from Circulan
and aunt they. We'll Frank I ought
to get my furlough about the last
half of February or the first part
of March for sure. I'll be glad
to see you if I can. I'll be glad
to see all the boys if it was
possible I hope I see a couple of
them anyway. You know Nick
Sinopale got a discharge from the
army and he a lucky guy I hope I
could get me too but I suppose I
can. We'll Frank take it easy
I hope to see you soon.
