We'll Frank out here its pretty rugged we do physical training every morning and in a small tube every afternoon and one night tube every week. My dogs feel as if they went through a grinding machine. Everything is rationed all up here even the water the stuff we do get is pretty hard to get. Cigarettes cost us 5¢ a pack but 3¢ same as on a ship I think. Boy its hotter than hell down here and they expect it to get hotter boy I am getting a sun tan. Did you receive the first letter I sent you? We'll Frank say hello to the folks back home for me. Send me a picture of yourself in a sailor suit I'd appreciate it very much. So long and good luck to you.
