know how I make out.

Here I am just talking about
myself & my girl but that's about
all I know what to talk about.
It means my future & my life
Frank and she is the only girl
I ever loved & know that she
will keep me happy.

Will the war be over now & I
let you know what is going to
happen to me. I'll let you just
what I'm doing now & how I
stand. Last night now we just
doing nothing. Just resting & waiting
for orders. I guess you know
about the point system and
how many you need to get
home. Well I have exactly
110 points. But a bit don't

pretty busy talking & thinking of
what to do. I still haven't found
a way out. There are ways but
we don't care for them too much.
I want to get married the legitimate
way. That way she can get ~~me~~
back to the states much quicker
& easier. Other wise it will take
a long long time. How do you
see what I'm up against. Not
only that I'm about two hundred
miles away from her now & its
almost impossible for me to see
her again. I was only fifty miles
before & was able to see her
and a while but now its no
good. I'm trying to get paid
days & if I do I'll have to

you think? It only takes 85 to
get out so I stand a very good
chance of going home in the next
few months & then get discharged.
Boy, it sure sounds sweet but
I can't wait to see what's going
to happen. I am quite sure in
fact pointed that I'm not going
to visit Jasper. So we just have
to wait till its all over before
we sit back at her again. That
is the main reason why I don't want

war when I am a civilian again.
Our mail is not checked any more
so if there is something you want
to know just write & I'll tell
you about it. Right now I'm pretty
close to Geneva. So long brother &
good luck. I'll write again soon & but be
