Dear Nephew,

We received today your most welcomed letter + we are very glad to hear that you are in the best of health. As for not writing any sooner to us, well we understand perfectly, we know that if it was possible for you to write you would. Yes we are very much surprised to hear that you are in the Philippines, but then again that's where everyone is going now, either here or to some other island. The way the war looks out there, when you are I imagine it will take a long time for it to end. These Japs are pretty tough & don't give up so easy. We heard from my son Mario + he's coming along fine. As for him coming home now that Germany is hiked, well we don't know, it would be better though if he were to

stay in Germany, than come home, because
if he does come home, it will mean that
he will go to the Pacific after his furlough.
Well let's hope for the best anyway. As for
the rest of the family we are all fine. I
was operated on Feb. on appendix and a
rupture. but thank God I am feeling fine
now. Let's hope the war ends soon so that
we can all be together & then enjoy a
nice big plate of spaghetti.
