
DISSECTION OF THE CORPUS CALLOSUM.

The upper parts of the hemispheres have been removed down to the level of the corpus callosum, and the fibres of the corpus callosum traced outwards in different directions.

- 1. Genu of corpus callosum.
- 2. Body of corpus callosum.
- 3. Splenium of corpus callosum.
- 4. Stria longitudinalis mesialis.
- 5. Stria longitudinalis lateralis.
- 6. The bed or groove in which the cingulum lies.

- 7. Surface layer of the corpus callosum removed to show the transverse course pursued by the bundles of fibres of the corpus callosum.
- 8. Tapetum.
- 9. Forceps major.
- 10. The place where the callosal and corona radiata systems of fibres intersect.
