## HORIZONTAL SECTION NO. 2

View of a horizontal section cut through the level of the center of the orbits, showing both surfaces of the cut. In the upper picture may be seen the roofs of the orbits, and the roof of the nose, with the septum. Between the septum and the orbits are the ethmoid cells, and posterior to the nasal chamber, the ethmoidal sinuses, which are larger than the average. Just within the posterior edge of the wall are the internal carotid arteries ${ }^{-}$this should be remembered in cureting the sinuses. The lower picture shows the corresponding parts from above, looking downward toward the floor of the orbits and the nasal fossa.
