IMPERIAL STEREOSCOPIC ANATOMY OF THE HEAD AND NECK

THE NASAL CHAMBER SAGITTAL SECTION No. 3

Section -IX-- No. 17

This section is cut in the median line showing the external wall of the nasal chamber with a portion of the ethmoid scrolls removed, thus exposing the frontal sinus, the ostium frontale, hiatus semilunaries, the anterior ethmoidal cells, the sphenoidal sinus, the middle and inferior meati, the floor of the nose, the roof of the mouth, the alveolar process and a section of the central incisor tooth. All of these structures in this specimen can be classed as typal or typical anatomy with very slight possibility of becoming diseased except through accident.
