## FRONTAL SINUS No. 11

An anterior view of two sinuses. That on the right is extremely large extending from the right external angular process over toward the left atid measures $67 \mathrm{~m} . \mathrm{m}$., leaving but a slight space for the left frontal sinus which measures a out $15 \mathrm{~m} . \mathrm{m}$. The septum between these sinuses has an inclination of about $45^{\circ}$. The right sinus also extends well back over the orbit and into the crista galli.
