

# RADICAL MASTOIDECTOMY

## Operation for Mastoiditis, following a Chronic Suppurative Otitis Media

The same general operative procedure is followed as illustrated in the preceding stereograms Nos. 2 and 3. A complete simple mastoid operation is performed; then the posterior superior triangular quadrant of the observe auditory canal is removed down to the annular ring and including the external wall of the aditus. The incus and malleus are removed through this slit (5 m.m. wide). The stapes is undisturbed. The complete operation consists in converting the mastoid process, antrum, aditus ad. antrum, tympanic attic and tympanum proper into one continuous smooth cavity. Ossiculectomy of the malleus and incus.
