
## RELATION OF MASTOID ANTRUM TO MASTOID PROCESS

POSTERIOR VIEW. A rectangular sawed section has been removed from the posterior and central portion of the mastoid process, including the posterior superior squamous portion. This antrum is rather large, cells leading from it are plainly visible. A thin perpendicular bony septum separating tip cell. No. 4. The bony lamina covering the mastoid antrum in this specimen is deeper than usual. No. 1.
