
## IMPERIAL STEREOSCOPIC ANATOMY OF THE HEAD AND NECK

## DESCENDING FORTION OF LATERAL SINUS

**ANTERIORLY PLACED.** The opening into the mastoid antrum in this specimen is very small (4 m.m.), due to the encroacling upon it of the lateral sinus in this region. The mastoid cells are few and shallow. The internal table, covering the lateral sinus, fills almost completely the entire posterior and central portion of the mastoid process. This sinus is very superficial to the external cortex, especially at its superior turn (2 m.m.).
