
RELATION OF LATERAL SINUS BULB TO DESCENDING FACIAL CANAL

The entire wall of the auditory canal, anterior portion and tip, bony covering and cells of the mastoid process, exposing the facial canal throughout its course, have been removed, illustrating the intimate relation of the sinus at the bulb to the descending facial canal. Caution should be exercised while removing a mastoid tip.
