
## VERTICAL SECTION

INVERSE TYMPANIC VIEW. This specimen has been sawed just internal to the annular ring, revealing uniform arching of tympanic and antral tegmen. The tympanic membrane is in position and attached to the annular ring and anterior surface of the manubrium of the malleus. The smooth external surface of the aditus ad. antrum; above and posterior to the hory of the incur and the external superficial antral cells; also wall of the lateral sinus, as it hugs the posterior inferior boundary of the mastoid antrum. The position of the malleus and incus, how they lie in the tympanic attic; also the relation of the short process of the incus, to the aditus ad antrum are all typically portrayed.
