
## RELATION OF VESTIBULE TO INTERNAL AUDITORY CANAL

INFERIOR VIEW. The lower portion of temporal bone has been removed to level of internal auditory canal, exposing vestibule of cochlea, cochlea and inferior surface of ossicular chain. The vestibule No. 6 is seen to the right and on a horizontal plane with the int. aud. canal No. 5. The cochlea No. 1 just above the auditory canal.
