"If the beast who sleeps in man could be held down by threats," Pasternak wrote, "any kind of threats, whether of jail or of retribution after death — then the highest emblem of humanity would be the lion tamer in the circus with his whip, not the prophet who sacrificed himself. But don't you see, this is just the point — what has for centuries raised men above the beast is not the cudgel but an inward music, the irresistible power of unarmed truth, the powerful attraction of its example."

This, I believe, must be our watchword in educating for the twenty-first century.

DAVID LEROY CORBITT. *The Formation of the North Carolina Counties, 1663-1943*. Raleigh: State Department of Archives and History. Second Printing, 1969. 323pp. \$5.00.

This work first appeared in 1950 and has been out of print for a number of years. It is a standard reference work, essential to every North Carolina library. This facsimile reprint has many new entries, additional information, and some corrections included in a seven-page supplement. It is printed on better paper and is more substantially bound than the first printing, and the older copies might well be discarded and replaced by this one.

EVERETT CRAVEN. *Reconstruction, The Ending of the Civil War*. New York: Holt, Rinehard and Winston, Inc., 1969. 330pp. \$3.95 pa.

Prof. Craven, a native of North Carolina, has long been recognized as one of the nation's leading historians of the Civil War and Reconstruction. This book is the culmination of a lifetime of study and thought; it was written because Prof. Craven "just wanted to know why Reconstruction failed and was abandoned."
