PRE-GAME DOPE

East Carolina will open their 1956 schedule tonight against the Norfolk Navy. It will be the fourth meeting of the two teams since 1952. The Pirates a 2-1 edge in the series, with a 21-0 victory in 1954, and a 6-0 decision in 1955. Navy got their only win in the initial contest, 13-7.

The Tars, who have been practicing since the first of August, will bring a host of talent to College Stadium in hopes of revenging last years defeat. Coaching the Tars will be Jack "Flying" Cloud, former All-American from William and Mary. Running the team at quarterback will be George Welsh, All-American last fall from Navy. Welsh was the top passer in the country last season. Also on hand will be Richie Mc-Abe, former Pittsburg Steeler half back.

The Bucs of Coach Jack Boone are also expected to throw an aerial attack into tonights tilt. Expected to match Welsh for the Pirates will be All-Conference and All-American candidate, Dick Cherry and Gary Mattocks.

The Pirates will journey to Bluefield W. Virginia next Saturday for a game with V. P. I., a Southern Conference foe.
