
The Pirates are ranked second in



## a gleam from the other team

Number 42, Claude Wayne Geiger, is Marshall University's first 1,000-yard rusher in history in initial season with 1,039 yards last season in eleven games. The 23 year old 6'-2, 184 lbs. senior tailback is a native of East Bank, West Virginia. C. W. started all eleven games last season, but suffered a shoulder separation in the final game. He has posted such school records as most rushes in a single game with 35 carries and most rushes in a season with 247 carries. Geiger is one of only two Marshall backs to gain 100 or more yards in four consecutive games. C. W. finished 21st in the nation among collegiate runners with an average of 22.4 carries and 94.5 yards per game last season.



Geiger transferred to Marshall from Michigan State where he played football as a Freshman.



## CHANCELLOR

Dr. Thomas B. Brewer became the seventh administrative official in the 71year history of East Carolina University last spring when he was named the new chancellor succeeding retiring chancellor Dr. Leo W. Jenkins.

Dr. Brewer, a 45-year-old native of Fort Worth, Texas, served as Vice Chancellor and Dean of Texas Christian University for the last five years. Dr. Brewer also held teaching and administrative posts at universities in Texas, Ohio, Iowa, and Kentucky. Dr. Brewer holds the Ph.D from the University of Pennsylvania in American History. He received the B.A. and M.A. degrees from the University of Texas-Austin. As an undergraduate, he participated in the liberal arts honors program and held a United Daughters of the Confederacy scholarship. As Vice Chancellor and Dean of the University at TCU, Dr. Brewer held responsibility for all academic programs, admissions, and organized research, served as chairman of the University Council, exofficio member of the Faculty Senate and as institutional representative on the interuniversity council.

As Dean of Arts and Sciences, he chaired the college curriculum committee and served on such committees as the university council, courses of study, university-wide teacher education, effective teaching and curriculum revision.


At Texas Christian, as Dean of Arts and Sciences, he served on a committee which revised university general education requirements and on the University Courses of Study Committee.

Dr. Brewer has published books, book reviews and articles for scholarly journals and periodicals and biographies. He is general editor of the Railroads of America series, a projected series of 20 to 25 volumes of history of various American railroads being published by the MacMillan Company.

Dr. Brewer is married and the father of three children.






## HEAD COACH

He's undoubtedly the most popular collegiate football coach in North Carolina today.


Name's Dye. Pat Dye. He's the head coach at East Carolina University and in four short years the 38year-old native of Blythe, Georgia has guided the Pirates to an impressive 32-12 overall record including a Southern Conference Championship in 1976. coach in East Carolina history to coach a team to four consecutive winning years.

Pat was born November 6, 1939 in Blythe, Ga. and attended Richmond Academy where he was named the Lineman of the Year in 1956. He also captained the team that year which won the state championship. He then went to the University of Georgia where he co-captained the Bulldogs and was named All-America during his senior season. He



Dye also participated in the Blue-Gray Classic, the Senior Bowl and the Coaches All-America game.

Dye has led his Pirates to seasons of 7-4, 8-3, 9-2 and 8-3 and is only the second



After graduating from Georgia, Pat played two years as an outside corner linebacker with the Edmonton Eskimoes in the Canadian Football League. Coach Dye served for two and one-half years in the Army and was discharged as a First Lieutenant.

He then served as an assistant coach at Alabama for nine years from 1965 until 1973. Dye was in charge of linebackers and recruiting while under Paul "Bear" Bryant.

Pat and his wife Sue have four children; Pat Jr., Missy, Brett, and Wanda.

#### PITT - PLAZA CENTER

First Game: Played on September 21, 1963 against Wake Forest. Won by the Pirates, 20-10. At that time only the south stands, five sections and a press, were built.

1968: The north stands, five sections were added to bring the capacity to 20,000 seats!

New Lighting: In the spring of 1975, a new lighting system was added. The finest lighting system in the state, the system is made up of metallic and incandescent lighting which contains 384 fixtures of 1,500 watts each on six 162-foot towers.

1978: This year marks the completion of the new look at Ficklen. A total of 35,000 seats, additions to all four corners, will make up the new look totaling 24 sections. Also assisting in a more workable facility, is a new three level press box and a 20' x 40' computerized scoreboard.

Rest Rooms: Men's and women's rest rooms are located at each end and the center of both sides of the stadium.

First Aid: Service will be provided by the Greenville Rescue Squad with a unit at the west end of the stadium.



Founded in 1907 as East **Carolina Teachers Training** School, ECU has grown from an enrollment of 123 in 1909 to more than 13,000 in August, 1977. During its more than six decades of service, the University has become the focal point

Allied Health Professions, Art, Business, Education, Home Economics, Music, Medicine, and Nursing.

The face of the University is always changing. Twenty years ago there were 17 buildings on a 98 acre campus with a total physical plant value of \$5 million. Today there are more than 60 buildings on a campus encompassing approximately 600 acres adjacent to downtown Greenville. Most of the classroom buildings, research

facilities, and residence halls are less than 13 years old. Currently, the physical plant is valued at more than \$80,000,000.

With an operating budget of over \$36 million annually, East Carolina is a national leader in teacher preparations. Greenville itself is a town of 30,000 located in the rich coastal plains of Eastern North Carolina. Pitt County, of which Greenville is the county seat, leads the nation in the production of leaf tobacco.

of development in Eastern North Carolina.

ECU leads the South in the preparation of teachers. In 1920 the school was authorized to offer four year teacher education degrees and to grant the bachelor of arts degrees. A year later by an act of the General Assembly, the school name was changed to East Carolina Teachers College. A major turning point for ECU came in 1960 when Dr.

Leo Jenkins was inaugurated as the school's sixth president. East Carolina College became East Carolina University in 1967



and enrollment more than doubled in a 10 year period. **Today East Carolina has** academic programs to offer 105 undergraduate degrees and 69 graduate degrees. Besides the College of Arts and Sciences and the Graduate School, there are eight professional schools:
