

George the second &c Know ye that we have
given and granted unto Saml Swann six
hundred and forty acres in Bath County lying
and being on the West-side the N.W. branch
of Cape Fear River about three miles above the
mines Beginning at a chestnut oak running
thence South sixty seven degrees and a half
West two hundred and fifty P, thence North
22 degrees and a half West 260 pole -
thence North 67 degrees and a half East
540 pole to a hickory, then down the me-
anders of the River to the first Station. To
Hold &c Witnesses &c the 20th of October 1728

E. Gale, G. Gale, Tho. Pollock, J Morley.)
