## FACULTY SENATE

## Minutes of May 16, 1973

The organizational meeting of the Faculty Senate for 1973-74 was held on Wednesday, May 16, 1973 at 3:00 p.m. in Room 101, Nursing Building. Mr. Woodside called the meeting to order and the secretary called the roll. The following members were absent: Fabisch, Moeller, Southerland, Heckrotte, McGee, Pertalion, Brown, Eagan, Wang, Shea, Barnes, Distefano, H. Jones, Spickerman, Hoots.

Mr. Woodside announced that at the Board of Trustees meeting the East Carolina University Code was referred to a subcommittee and that Chairman Morgan had promised that the group would reconvene before July 1, 1973 to consider it.

Miss Marguerite Perry presented the Nomination Committee report. The committee had nominated Robert Woodside for Chairman, Carl Adler for Vice-Chairman, and Stella Daugherty for Secretary. Mr. Garlan Bailey presided during the election for Chairman. Ha asked for nominations from the floor. Mr. Steelman moved nominations be closed. The motion was seconded and passed. Mr. Woodside was reelected Chairman.

Mr. Woodside asked if there were any nominations from the floor for Vice Chairman. Mr. Yarbrough moved nominations be closed. The motion was seconded and passed. Mr. Adler was elected Vice Chairman.

Mr. Woodside asked for nominations from the floor for Secretary. Mr. Yarbrough moved nominations be closed. The motion was seconded and passed. Mrs. Stella Daugherty was reelected Secretary.

The Chairman asked for nominations for the Agenda Committee. He explained that the committee was to consist of the officers of the Senate as ex-officio members and 5 members elected from the Senate. The following 5 persons were nominated. Vernie Wilder, Jimmie Grimsley, Walter Calhoun, Carolyn Hampton, Tinsley Yarbrough. Miss P. Daugherty moved nominations be closed. Mr. M. Williams seconded and the motion passed. The Chairman declared the Agenda Committee elected by acclamation.

Mr. Woodside explained that the Senate would now elect five members to the Committee on Committees. These nominees did not have to be Senators. The following people were nominated: Henry Ferrell, Ray Martinez, R. B. Keusch, Byron Coulter, Constantine Kledaras, Garlan Bailey, Evelyn Perry. Mr. Yarbrough moved nominations be closed. Miss Schmidt seconded. Mr. Grossnickle and Mr. Yarbrough acted as tellers. Ferrell, Keusch, Coulter, Kledaras, and Perry were elected on the first ballot. Martinez and Bailey tied. Mr. Grossnickle and Mr. McDaniel acted as tellers on the second ballot. Mr. Bailey was elected.

Mr. McDaniel presented the Committee on Committees nominations to the academic and standing committees. Mr. Woodside asked if there were any nominations from the floor. Mr. Lloyd Benjamin was nominated for the Library Committee. Mr. Donnalley moved that the nominations be accepted except for the Library Committee. The motion was seconded and passed. The Senate then voted by secret ballot for two of the three nominees. Nominated were Lloyd Benjamin, C. T. Martoccia, Douglas J. McReynolds. Mr. Grossnickle and Mr. McDaniel acted as tellers. Mr. Benjamin and Mr. McReynolds were elected. The members elected to the committees are the names in parentheses on the attachment.

Mr. Woodside announced that under the new constitution the Parliamentarian is appointed. Mr. Woodside appointed Henry Ferrell as Parliamentarian.
