Admissions Committee Recommendation

It is recommended that some East Carolina University students ruled academically ineligible to return be readmitted on probation, upon appealing to the Admissions Committee, after they have been out of college during the regular academic year for a period of three years. The conditions outlined below must be met by these students in order for them to be readmitted.

This policy will be administered on an individual basis by appeal to the Admissions Committee beginning Spring Quarter of the 1973-74 academic year. Statistics will be maintained on students admitted under this policy for a follow-up study to be completed at the end of two years.

In order for a student to be eligible under this program he should have been out of college (ECU) for a period of three or more academic years. A student may be admitted under the provisions of this policy only one time. The following procedure will govern the retention and awarding of credit based on the prior transcript:

1. Retention: Students, after readmission, must have a "C" average upon completion of 27 quarter hours of course work. They must meet catalogue requirements after that time.
2. Previous grades below "C" will not be used in the determination of the student's grade point average except for the calculation of honors.
3. Credit toward graduation will not be granted for any previous course work with a grade below "C". (This means that if a person completed sequence courses such as Biology 70 with a "D" and Biology 71 with a "C" he would not get credit for Biology 70.)
