The Credits Committee wishes to make the following recommendation to the Faculty Senate: "In those situations where a student has failed a given course repeatedly, commencing with the third failure the hours of credit offered for the course shall not be counted as attempted hours in computing the student's grade-point average."

It is recommended this change be made effective as soon as practical, and it is further recommended that the proposed change be made retroactive, as well as prospective.

The purpose of this proposed change is to eliminate distortion in a student's transcript where that distortion is attributable to his inability to cope with one specific type of course.
