VI. Committee Organization, Subcommittees, Research Activities, etc.

The Committee consists of six faculty members and one student member plus ex-officio: Danforth and Woodrow Wilson Representative, Dean of Student Affairs, Financial Aid Officer, the President of the League of Scholars and that person's designated alternate (the Vice President of the League of Scholars).

VII. Committee Actions

- A. Eleven scholarships were approved as requested by departments and other units. Two hundred and eighty athletic grants-in-aid were approved (see Appendix 1).
- B. Invited selected National Merit Semifinalists to an ECU weekend. Nine students attended.
- C. A letter was sent to 1481 Merit Scholar semifinalists encouraging them to consider ECU for their education.
- D. Submitted a resolution to the Faculty Senate requiring units to inform the Committee of all scholarships awarded. (See Appendix 2)
- E. Upon the deaths of James McDaniel and John Davis, the Committee offered unanimous resolutions of appreciation for the services of these members and composed and sent letters of condolence to the deceased members' wives the letters were made a part of the Committee minutes.
- F. Adopted a procedure to be used by units in reporting scholarships.
- G. Discussed the status of the League of Scholars.
- H. Met with Chancellor Brewer to discuss the future role of the Committee
- I. Adopted a motion that the Chair of the Committee discuss with Vice Chancellor Howell the concern of the Committee regarding the loss of money for the string scholarships.

Appendix 2. Resolution Presented to the Faculty Senate

WHEREAS, The East Carolina University Scholarships, Fellowships, and Financial Aid Committee is charged with recommending policies in the granting of scholarships; and,

WHEREAS, The federal funding for the financial aid programs administered by the University will depend upon accurately reporting all scholarships awarded by the University; and,

WHEREAS, Schools and departments within the University have, in the past, awarded scholarships without notifying the Committee of the method of the selection of recipients, the names of recipients or the amount of the awards.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That schools and departments within the University identify the scholarships, report their procedures for selecting scholarship recipients, the names of the recipients and the amounts of the awards to the Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That requests from various departments and schools to the Committee to award scholarships follow the procedures recommended by the Committee.

NOTE: The Faculty Senate at its meeting on December 12, 1978, deleted the last paragraph and passed the resolution.

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
