Committee organized into three subcommittees: "A" chaired by Dr. Adler, "B" chaired by Dr. Boyette, "C" chaired by Dr. Debnath, and "D" chaired by Dr. Debnath.

Committee and subcommittees A, B, and C read all 114 proposals. Subcommittees recommended or did not recommend proposals to full committee. Subcommittee D reconciled all budgets with monies available. Full committee voted on all proposals. Six subcommittees were created in order to develop application form with guidelines, to evaluate grant proposals and to make recommendation to the full committee.
