Faculty Senate of East Carolina University
Organizational Meeting of 1978/79 Academic Year
19 April 1978

The organizational meeting of the Faculty Senate for 1978/79 was called to order by Chairman Henry Ferrell on Wednesday, April 19, 1978 at 2:10 p.m. in Room 221, Mendenhall Student Center. The secretary called the roll. The following members were absent: Tadlock (Aerospace), Kane (Allied Health), Hines (Business), Ray (Drama & Speech), Stone (Education), Mikkelsen (Education), Riggs (Geology), Pories (Medicine), Brinn (Medicine), Haritun (Music), Kirkpatrick (Nursing), Shackelford (Nursing), Coble (Science Education), Rhea (Sociology and Anthropology). The following ex-officio members were absent: Jenkins, Holt, Monroe, Howell, M. Moore, P. Adler, and P. Daugherty.

Agenda Item 3: Rodney Schmidt, Chair of the Committee on Committees, presented the committee's nominations for committee assignments and explained how the selection were made. Only volunteers were nominated. An attempt was made to maintain academic balance and special consideration was given to those nominated for the University Computer Committee. Secret ballots were used by the committee.

(Coble joined the session.)

Kares asked how many people volunteered for the Calendar Committee. Schmidt replied 42. I. Ryan nominated William Grossnickle for the University Curriculum Committee. The vote was taken by secret ballot with Woodside and Johnson as tellers.

Bland, S. Daugherty, Richards, and Grossnickle were elected to the University Curriculum Committee by the highest majority.

Zincone nominated Jung-Gun Kim for the Faculty Governance Committee. Graham nominated Hazel Stapleton, and Ayers nominated James McDaniel. Woodside and Johnson served as tellers.

Caspar and Fulghum were elected to the Faculty Governance Committee by the highest majority.

Woodside moved to accept the nominations as presented by the Committee on Committees with the exception of the Faculty Governance and University Curriculum Committees. The motion passed by voice vote. (See attachment.)

Agenda Item 4: Lao took the chair. Artemis Kares presented the nominee for Chairman of the Faculty: Henry Ferrell. There being no further nominations, I. Ryan moved that Henry Ferrell be elected by unanimous ballot for the Chairman of the Faculty. Grossnickle seconded, and the motion passed by voice vote.

Ferrell resumed the chair and expressed his appreciation of the Senate's vote. Kares presented the nominees for Vice Chairman of the Faculty: William Grossnickle and

Ione Ryan. The vote was taken by secret ballot with Woodside and Johnson as tellers.

Ione Ryan was elected Vice Chairman of the Faculty.

Kares presented the nominee for Secretary of the Faculty: Eugene Ryan. There being no further nominations, Hursey moved the ballot of the body be cast in the majority. Johnson seconded and the motion passed by voice vote.

Agenda Item 5: The Chair opened the floor for the Senate to elect five Senators to the Agenda Committee for the next academic year and read the charge of the committee. Kares nominated Judy Donnalley; S. Daugherty nominated Robert Hursey; Hursey nominated Artemis Kares; Kares withdrew her name; P. Daugherty nominated Carolyn Bolt; Ayers nominated Vincent Mikkelsen; Johnson nominated Janice Faulkner. C. Adler moved nominations be closed and Grossnickle seconded. Allen moved the ballot be cast in the majority for the slate. Woodside seconded and the motion passed by voice vote. Judy Donnalley, Robert Hursey, Carolyn Bolt, Vincent Mikkelsen, and Janice Faulkner were elected to the Agenda Committee for 1978/79.

Agenda Item 6: The Chair opened the floor for the Senate to elect five members to the Committee on Committees for the next academic year and noted these did not have to be Senators. He read the charge of the Committee. Fulghum nominated Conner Atkeson; Bolt nominated Michael Bassman; Donnalley nominated Artemis Kares; S. Daugherty nominated Robert Woodside; Ayers nominated Donald Clemens; Hursey nominated Lawrence Hough; Price nominated Bodo Nischan; Allen nominated James McDaniel; Grossnickle nominated Rosina Lao; and E. Ryan nominated Rodney Schmidt. Woodside noted that Schmidt was already an ex-officio member of the committee as past chair. Ferrell added that Schmidt could be elected as a regular member. C. Adler and Johnson served as tellers.
