RESOLVED, That the Chancellor of East Carolina University be requested to direct a study of the current policies concerning key control and admission to academic buildings during nights, weekends, and holidays. The purpose of this study would be to determine whether a more flexible system might be adopted.

Agenda Item 5C: Attachment - Faculty Governance Committee

A. The Faculty Governance Committee recommends the following revisions in the Code of Operations for the Department of Library Science:

Section IV, second paragraph, first sentence Chairman should read Chairperson. Section IV C.1.d., his should read his/her. Section VII Meetings, second paragraph should read: Departmental meetings shall be held at least twice a month. . . Each committee shall meet at least twice a semester.

- WHEREAS, The East Carolina University Student Scholarships, Fellowships, and Financial Aid Committee is charged with recommending policies in the granting of scholarships; and,

- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That schools and departments within the University identify the scholarships, report their procedures for selecting scholarship recipients, the names of the recipients and the amounts of the awards to the Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That requests from various departments and schools to the Committee to award scholarships follow the procedures recommended by the Committee.
