FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION 79-36

- WHEREAS, Academic counselors have been in need of more information to aid in the student advising responsibilities in the General College, and
- WHEREAS, Enrollment projections for the next few years predict a reduced pool of applicants for admittance at East Carolina University, and
- WHEREAS, Every reasonable effort should be made to retain those students who are recruited;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That all midsemester grades for each general college student will be collected by Registrar, and forwarded to the Dean of General College ten working days prior to preregistration each semester. General College will distribute these grades to appropriate faculty advisors five working days prior to preregistration. If any student academic performance is deficient, the report will be accompanied by information that will assist each advisor in providing descriptive academic counseling concerning correction of deficiencies and responsive planning for the next semester.

Brewer East Carolina University Dear Chancellor Brewer: At its first regular meeting on September 25, 1979, the Faculty Senate of East Carolina University approved the following resolutions: Attached resolution from the Calendar Committee (79-35)proposing the calendar for Summer School 1981 is recommended for your approval. Resolution was approved without a dissenting vote. The General College Committee proposes the attached (79 - 36)resolution concerning midsemester grades for General College students for your consideration. This proposal generated considerable discussion and a show of hands was necessary to determine the recommendation of the Senate. (25 for - 18 against) The attached resolution with regard to faculty salaries (79-37)in the 16 state-supported institutions was approved without a dissenting vote with the request that you send a copy of the resolution to President Friday. The Senate appreciates your consideration of these matters. It is particularly important that should you agree to forward resolution 79-37 to President Friday that this be done in order to reach his office prior to the Faculty Assembly Meeting on Friday, September 28, 1979.
