There will be no departure from the printed schedule, except as noted below: All examinations for one credit hour courses and/or evening and Saturday classes will be held during the last regular meeting of the class. Classes meeting more than three times a week will follow the examination schedule for MWF classes.

Exception: Examinations in graduate courses (5000, 6000, 7000) meeting at night on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and in the morning on Saturday will be held on the first night or the morning of their usual meeting during the examination period (December 9 through December 16), excluding reading day, rather than on the last regular meeting of the class.

Those classes beginning between hours will have the final examination at the time scheduled for the hour during which the class begins (e.g., 9:30-11:00 TTh will meet the exam schedule of the 9:00 a.m. TTh class).

#### SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN ECU CALENDAR

1. Inclusion of fall break (Monday, Tuesday) on 6, 7, or 8th weekend
2. Make up fall break by having classes on Labor Day and extending semester 1 day.
3. Rotate common exam schedule.
4. Revise regular exam schedule to adjust for exam periods with very few classes.
5. Extend drop-add one day for the Spring semester.
