SUBCOMMISSION ON ORGANIZATION
CHARGE

1 The Subcommittee on Organization shall provide recommendations for the most
2 effective academic and administrative organization of the University.

3 These recommendations will be drawn primarily from the preliminary proposals
4 of the Subcommissions on Academic Programs, Academic Support, Institutional
5 Support, Student Service, and Public Service. The Organization Subcommittee
6 shall review task force reports evolved from questions developed by the Sub-
7 commissions concerning faculty, academic and administrative organization.

8 The Subcommittee on Organization shall recommend a ten-year master plan for
9 the location and assignment of University facilities. This shall include
10 a reassessment of present facility assignments and future additions to the
11 physical plant. Alternative plans shall be developed.

12 The Subcommittee on Organization shall review additional recommendations
13 developed by task forces involved in the planning process; it shall estab-
14 lish Task Forces to review:

- 15 - Faculty Organization that shall include evaluations of General
16 Faculty Organizations.
- 17 - Academic Organization that shall include academic committees, the
18 Faculty Senate, its committees, and other pertinent areas for improve-
19 ments, shared by the Faculty Senate and the Administration.
- 20 - Administrative organization that shall include administrative com-
21 mittees, other than those shared by the Faculty Senate and the
22 Administration, and other pertinent subjects and recommend, if neces-
23 sary, improvements.

24 The Subcommittee on Organization shall submit a preliminary "Draft III" with
25 planning priorities for consideration and evaluation by the Planning
26 Commission.
