CREDITS COMMITTEE

Revised Charge

November 10, 1981

- 1. Name: Credits Committee
- 2. Membership: 5 faculty members, one student member, plus ex officio: Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, or an appointed representative.
- 3. Quorum: 3 faculty members exclusive of ex officio.
- 4. A. Committee Functions:

The Credits Committee: (1) reviews policies and practices pertaining to academic credits and academic standards. Matters of concern include academic credits and grading policies, absentee policies, drop policies, withdrawal policies, and multiple F policies; (2) serves as an appeals board for students who wish to appeal administrative decisions involving the interpretation and enforcement of policies pertaining to academic credits and standards.

B. To Whom Committee Reports:

The Credits Committee (1) recommends policies and practices pertaining to academic credits and academic standards to the Faculty Senate; (2) forwards the Committee's student appeal decisions on student appeals to the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs.

C. How Often Committee Reports:

The Committee reports to the Faculty Senate as often as necessary, but at least once a year.

D. Power of the Committee to Act:

The Committee is empowered to make decisions in student appeal cases.
